CHANDANNAGAR PARIBESH UNNAYAN SAMITY MEMORANDUM OF ASSOCIATION

1. The Name of the Samity : CHANDANNAGAR PARIBESH
UNNAYAN SAMITY

3. The area of Operation : Geographical area of West Bengal

4. CHANDANNAGAR PARIBESH UNNAYAN SAMITY is a non political Voluntary Organisation and the objectives for which the samity is established are :

- i) To make organised efforts to keep the city and the surrounding areas of Chandannagar clean, beautiful and pollution free.
- ii) To create and promote mass awareness about healthy environment and better living conditions.
- iii) To enlighten citizen of Chandannagar about the evils of pollution and motivate them to take appropriate measures against all kinds of urban pollution.
- iv) To carry on sustained publicity and public relations campaign on healthy environment and pollution control through publication and distribution of leaflets, posters, folders, booklets etc., display of cinema slides, films, hoardings, banners, festoons, T.V. advertisement, street seminars, workshops etc. at school, colleges, clubs, public halls and public places, arranging essay, debate and quiz and other forms of environment related competition for students and general public and conducting various kinds of literary, social and cultural

activities connected with environment consciousness, holding exhibitions, padajatra and other mass educative programmes on pollution free healthy living.

- V) To co-ordinate with and to participate and assist in the programme on pollution control and environment promotion programmes of Government, Civic Bodies, Institutions and other organisations as and when such occasion will arise, provided they do not collide with activities and objectives of the Samity.
- vi) To co-ordinate and liaison with the Local Bodies such as Municipal Corporation, Borugh committee, Ward councillors etc. and Zilla Parishad, Panchayat Samities etc. Administrative Authorities like DIstrict Magistrate, S. D. O., B.D.O. etc., and different concerned Departments of the Government like Health, P.W.D., Police, Forest, Environment etc and also such bodies like Pollution Control Board, CMDA etc. for solution of any specific or general nature of problems connected with better environment, healthy living and pollution free life of the citizens.
- vii) To offer constructive suggestions of proposals to the civic bodies and administrative authorities for improvement of enviroment, civic amenities, quality of life in the area through letters, memorandums, personal negotiations, deputations etc.
- viii) To resist and oppose by peaceful means and legitimate process any work and scheme by any authority or organisation or individual which is detrimental to environment and biodiversity conservation. Howerver in extreme cases Samity may move for legal support considering the merit and gravity of the case.

- ix) To motivate the citizens to voluntary efforts for solving local minor environmental problems and taking initiative in area wise development of environmental matters through peoples' participation.
- x) To set up area or ward wise units of Samity in order to decentralise its activities and to bring about balance and sustainable developments.
- xi) To take up in the town, solely or jointly with other organisations beautification programmes such as tree plantation, setting up and maintenance of gardens and parks and decorative islands etc. as also to take care of the beautification of the town in general and the Strand areas in particular.
- xi) To raise necessary funds through members' subscriptions and donations, sponsorships, charity shows and grants or any other help from the State or Central Government or any other Private or Public bodies or individuals for carrying on Samity's activities in fulfilment of its objectives and to maintain accounts thereof in proper manner as required under rules and regulations.

The income and properties of the samity whatever derived or obtained shall be applied solely towards promotion of the object of the Samity and no portion thereof shall be paid to or divided amongst any of its members by way of profits.

Regulations of Chandannagar Paribesh Unnayan Samity (as amended upto November, 2018)

1. Membership

Chandannagar Paribesh Unnayan Samity is a non-political Voluntary Organisation with its membership open to Indian Citizens irrespective of Caste, Community and Sex affirming solidarity with and faith in the objectives and programmes of the Samity. The Executive Committee, however, by majority decision may refuse to admit any person whose admission is considered detrimental to the interest the Samity.

2. Types of Membership

- i) *Honorary Members* : Any person whose connection with the Samity is deemed to be useful, may with the consent of such person be elected as Hony. Member of the Samity. Such members shall not, however, be eligible to be member of the Executive Committee or to vote in any meeting.
- ii) *Life Member* : There shall be Life Members on payment of a One-Time subscription of Rs. 1300/-
- iii) *General Member* : Any person qualified to be member and paying prescribed membership fee may be admitted as General Member of the Samity.

SUBSCRIPTIONS : (As amended in A.G.M dt 27.5.2018)

- i) *Hony. Member* : No Subscription.
- ii) *Life Member* : Rs. 1300/- (One-time Subscription during whole life). Any member will be eligible to get life membership who has continuous membership as general member for four years. The E.C. will approve the prayer of the members for getting the Life Membership.

- iii) *General Member* : Rs. 100/- Annual Subscription and Rs. 100/- (admission Fee for the 1st year and for onetime)
- iv) *Associate Member* : No Subscription. (For school/ college students only and having no voting rights)

3. Cessation of Membership

- i) On one's own decision to resign.
- ii) Non-payment to subscription.
- iii) Indulgence in activities contrary to the objectives and interest of the Samity, if proved and subject to retification in the next AGM after keeping him under suspension till then.
- iv) Conviction, moral turpitude, insanity etc.

4. Register of Members

The Samity shall maintain a Register of Members containing names, addresses, occupation, age, category, date of admission and cessation of membership. The Register may be inspected by any member on prior requisition to the Secretary.

5. Tenure of Membership

Membership will remain valid for one year from the date of admission and may be renewed from the termination date without further admission fee.

6. Rights And Obligations of Members

Any General member and Life Member of the Samity has the right (i) to elect and to be elected in the Executive Committee of the Samity. (ii) to submit suggestion for discussion to the Executive Committee and Sub Committee on any matter pertaining to the Samity. (iii) to inspect the accounts and proceedings of the meetings of the Samity on appointment with the Secretary. (iv) to take part in the activities and programmes of the Samity. (v) to pay his subscription within the prescribed time limit.
